AND WHEREAS, vide Rule 10 read with Rule 39 of the Arms Rules, 2016, the Govt. of India has permitted international medalists and renowned shooters to issue Training Certificate in terms of Form S1 of the said Rules. AND WHEREAS the Maharashtra Rifle Association (hereinafter referred to as "MRA" for the sake of brevity) being the Apex body for the shooting sport in the state of Maharashtra and in view of the misuse and exploitation of persons seeking to apply for grant of arms license, has hereby imposed the below rules to be adhered to by all DRA/Club/Affiliates/Athletes. Any anomaly/ discrepancy arising out of interpretation of the present rules shall be dealt with by the General Secretary, MRA, in consultation with the Working Committee, MRA whose decision in the matter shall be final.

1. A renowned shot/ international medalist issuing the S1 certificate must have completed 21 years of age on the date of issuing such S1 certificate. A renowned shot/ international medalist in the Air Pistol/ Air Rifle events shall not be eligible to issue S1 certificates signifying training in firearms.
2. Each S1 certificate issued by a renowned shooter/ international medalist shall be countersigned by the General Secretary of the DRA/Club/Affiliate or the Authorized Officer so designated by the DRA/Club/Affiliate. Such countersign shall signify that the training imparted by the renowned shooter/ international medalist in terms of S1 certificate has been given at the ranges of such DRA/Club/Affiliate having adequate facilities and equipment for firearm training.
3. The total fees chargeable by the renowned shooter/ international medalist issuing an S1 certificate including those payable to the DRA/Club/Affiliate for usage of the latter's facilities and/or equipment shall not exceed Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only).
4. The DRA/Club/Affiliate shall maintain a record of names of persons and such other details (dates on which training was given/ details of weapon used/ number of rounds fired) to whom S1 certificates have been issued under the countersign of the General Secretary/ Authorised Officer of such DRA/Club/Affiliate.
5. Any violation of the foregoing provisions will amount to indiscipline and shall be dealt with in accordance with the rules/ regulations of the Maharashtra Rifle Association established from time to time.
