Women athletes, who have already achieved ISSF MQS, as per Rule 17.6 in 25M Sports Pistol Women/Jr. Women/Masters/Senior Masters and Super Masters Women category during 67/68 NSCC will be allowed to participate in 69 NSCC. Subsequently, athletes desires of participation in these events must achieve MQS as laid down under Rule 1.4 and 17.6 of NRAI Match Book. Those women athletes, who qualify for 25M Sports Pistol event in Women/Jr. Women/Masters/Senior Masters and Super Masters Women from AIGVMSC/Zonal Championship 2026 will be allowed to participate in these events.

4. Amendment in Rule related to Dress Code as per ISSF.

16.17 Athletes participating in shooting competitions shall always maintain an appearance befitting sports person. The use of inappropriate, indecent, or unsporting attire is strictly prohibited. Athletes must report to the competition ranges and attend prize distribution ceremonies in proper team or competition uniform.

16.17.1 For the purpose of enforcing dress standards, the applicable ISSF Dress Code Rules shall be followed including prohibition of use of following:

Chappals and sandals

Blue Jeans

Sleeveless tops/mini skirts

All type of pants and shorts with external pockets like cargo pants and shorts.

16.17.2 In case of a first violation during the competition, the athlete shall be issued a warning by the range officials.

5. Amendments in Rule 11 of NRAI Match Book – Age Limit

11.1 Age criteria, as per ISSF Rule 3.7.4.12, will be applicable to all age category Athletes.

11.2 Age Categories:

Seniors	Above 21 years
Juniors	Below 21 years
Youth	Below 18 years
Sub Youth	Below 16 years
Masters	Between 45 years to 59 years
Senior Masters	Between 60 years to 69 years
Super Masters	70 years and above

11.3 The age eligibility for all age-category events shall be determined as on 31st December of the year in which the competition commences and shall remain unchanged for the entire duration of that competition, irrespective of whether it concludes in the following calendar year. For example, if a competition begins in December and concludes in January of the next year, the athlete's age category shall continue to be determined based on his/her age as on 31st December of the year in which the competition commenced, in accordance with the applicable ISSF Rules.

6. Amendment in rule 9.6 of NRAI Match Book (Tie Breaking)

9.6.1 **ISSF Rule Matches:**

9.6.1.1 Rifle/Pistol Matches: All ties shall be decided in accordance with ISSF Rule 6.15

9.6.1.2 Shotgun Matches: Ties shall be decided in accordance with ISSF Shotgun Rule 9.15

9.6.2 **NR Rule Matches:**

9.6.2.1 The highest number of inner tens

9.6.2.2 The highest score of last ten (10) shot series working backwards by 10 shot series in full ring scoring (not inner tens of decimals) until the tie is broken.

9.6.2.3 For Shotgun: On the count back basis

9.6.3 **Team Ties**

Ties in team events, including ties in the Qualification state of Mixed Team events, shall be decided by totaling the results of all members of a team and following the procedures for breaking individual ties.
